
Dear friend,

It is a joy to send out the first copies of our voter guide and thank our faithful supporters who make our mission of identifying and supporting pro-life candidates possible. Your generosity has also allowed us to partner with PCUC in a billboard campaign to change hearts and minds towards the sanctity of life and to expose the dangers and destruction of abortion. We send infrequent but important e-mails to our subscribers about legislation that we want to support or oppose.

We must choose our best candidates in this primary because Pennsylvania's elections this fall will determine whether we become a pro-life state like Florida or Texas or an abortion state like California or New York. Being pro-life has not always been such a party issue. As the back of our voter guide points out, in the early years of LifePAC a large majority of the candidates that we endorsed or identified as pro-life were Democrats. The only policy we have changed since then is that we no longer endorse candidates, we simply identify pro-life candidates. I have always said I we are not single-issue voters. We have a primary issue just like any honest voter will admit, but give us two pro-life candidates and we will make our choice based on other issues.

Currently the Democrats have a one vote majority in the House and a very pro-abortion Governor. The Senate has a small pro-life Republican majority which serves as the firewall to stop any radical pro-abortion bills or constitutional amendment that the House may pass. I'm sorry that the Democratic party has changed and abandoned their remaining pro-life members. This is the semi-annual appeal for your financial support that makes all of our efforts possible. I am proud of our low overhead costs (no rent, no utility costs, no vehicles). We only have one part time employee, small web site and internet expenses, and miserly printing and mailing costs plus lots of volunteers. After your contributions cover the fixed costs, we are able to give to selected candidates in contested races and even support efforts to change "hearts and minds". The only way we ultimately win this battle to protect innocent unborn lives and oppose physician assisted suicide is to love and support our neighbors who are vulnerable to these choices and make abortion an unthinkable option. The Lozier Institute has found that 60% of women who had abortions would have chosen life if they had either more emotional support or financial security.
